This Saturday evening and Sunday some of our second graders are receiving the Eucharist for the first time. congratulations to the First Communicants and their families, and thanks to the instructors in the religious education program and religious teachers from St. Michael's School for all their work in preparing the children for this Sacrament. It is important for parents to remember that the celebration of First Communion puts the emphasis on Communion, not first. The Eucharist should be a regular part of our life as Catholics. It is our belief that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist (see John's Gospel, Chapter 6) and that frequent Communion is a grace given to us to help us become stronger Christians. This year the children are receiving First Eucharist at our regularly scheduled weekend Masses. Seeing the joy of the children, as they receive the Real Presence of Christ for the first time, brings back memories of our own First Holy Communion. Thank you for praying for the children as our St. Michael Parish family welcomes them to the Table of the Lord.

First Communion Celebrations at St. Michael Parish

First Communions will be taking place during 4 Sunday masses this year: the 5

pm Mass on April 30 and May 7, and the 10:30 am Mass on May 1 and May 8.

The proper place for celebration of First Communion is within the Sunday liturgy which reinforces the idea that the Sacraments are never meant to be private events but part of the life of the entire Body of Christ, the Church. It is the Church gathered as the community of the faithful that initiates and welcomes people into the faith (*RCIA*). And so gathering with the People of God called to form the Body of Christ at St. Michael is an appropriate and excellent way of welcoming the children to the Table of the Lord. With the celebration of their *first* of *many* communions, we welcome these young people as they begin to participate more fully in the prayer and praise of God every Sunday. We hope that you will join in the celebration with the children and their families at these Sunday Masses over the next two weeks!

Eucharistic Flame Evangelist Comes to St. Michael Parish, Netcong

Rev. Dr. Joseph Vadakkel from India celebrated the monthly Healing Mass here at St. Michael Parish on Tuesday, April 26. He spoke about the joy, peace and hope that one can get when we keep Jesus close to us in our hearts through reception of the Eucharist as well as Eucharistic Adoration. Fr. Vadakkel brought a First Class Relic of St. Paul certified by the Vatican with him and blessed all those present individually with the Blessed Sacrament as well as with the relic. He is well known for his dissertation "The Eucharistic Flame Evangelization" which he continues to share with those he celebrates Healing Masses for. He was appointed the director of the Eucharistic Flame Evangelization for Europe in 2006. Fr. Vadakkel has also written two books; one of which is titled "Jesus - your Eucharistic Flame." One of his books can be purchased in Polish, Spanish, Slovakian as well as English. He received an apostolic blessing on July 17, 2009 from Pope Benedict XVI for his work on the Eucharistic Flame mission. Fr. Vadakkel continues to spread the message of the Eucharistic Flame as he continues his time here in New Jersey.
