From Fr. Adam, Pastor

On this Sunday, we celebrate the Holy Trinity Sunday. Last Sunday, we observed Pentecost and next week we will commemorate the feast of "Corpus Christi", the Body and Blood of Christ.

On the feast of Pentecost, God shows us the power of the Holy Spirit who remains with us as our link to Christ and to His Church. With the feast of the Holy Trinity, we are reminded that we have God the Father and Creator, God the Son and Redeemer, God the Holy Spirit and Sanctifier who are not just images on a picture but a presence in our life. It is a very uniquely Christian privilege to know the deep secret that God is a Trinity of Persons and, by grace, we can know each person of the Trinity. With the upcoming feast of Corpus Christi, God is reminding us that Jesus is really present in the Holy Eucharist. After the words of the Consecration during the Holy Sacrifice of the Eucharist, there is no more bread and wine on the altar but the real Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. Jesus is proving this in his many Eucharistic miracles, which we can read using the links provided below and on our website under the Resources tab.

Almighty God wants to be present in our lives in three persons. He wants to show us His almighty power. To be able to receive Him, we have to reject everything that is contrary to the Gospel, confess our sins and invite God to be present in our lives.

Last week, one person asked me to pray with him when I was at his house. He asked me to help him to deal with one problem. Before we started to talk, I offered him confession, the sacrament of Anointing and Holy Communion. After he received these three Sacraments, we started to pray spontaneously inviting God into his home and into his life. In that moment, we started to experience great joy and peace to the point that tears started to come from our eyes. After that prayer, there were no need for much discussion because the problem was gone.

God loves us and He does not want to abandon us. He will come when we ask and when our hearts are free and open for Him.
